Facilities wishing to utilise the services of an approved regulatory food safety auditor must meet the following conditions:

- 1. Have a satisfactory compliance history, (No outstanding improvement notices, no penalty notices or prosecutions in previous 3 years, a minimum of 2 A or B rated audits following a D or E rated audit)
- 2. For current licensees, have received either an A or B rating from the most recent audits,
- 3. For new licensees, have received either an A or B rating at two licensing audits,
- 4. Operate in an industry approved by the NSW Food Authority to move to the Third Party Audit system,
- 5. Operate at a risk level that has been approved by the NSW Food Authority to move to the Third Party Audit system, and

Please note: Export registered establishments need to supply written approval from the Australian Department of Agriculture and Water Resources before applying to utilise this system.
